

### Information and promotion programmes on Japanese and Hong Kong markets

- "EU beef on Asian markets"- a two-year programme aimed to promote beef (fresh, chilled and frozen) in Japan and Hong Kong. The main goal of the programme is to increase visibility of beef from the EU and to increase its exports into Japan and Hong Kong. The programme has been started in 2022.
- "Poultry with a European passport" a two-year programme implemented in the markets of China, Hong Kong and Japan. The programme aims at increase in the awareness of the values of poultry meat from Europe, which will result in growth in demand for high-quality poultry meat coming to Asia "with a European passport". The programme has been started in 2020.




### Poland and Polish food sector in the European Union

- 7th food exporter in EU
- Ca. 17.6 thousand companies and 458 thousand people working in the Polish food sector
- Sales value 14% of GDP



#### Polish foreign trade in agri-food products



#### of Polish agri-food exports in January – July 2023



of Polish agri-food exports in January – July 2023




#### The largest beef producers in the world in 2021


#### The largest beef producers in the EU-27 in 2022


## Cattle farms in Poland according to the farming scale in 2022


#### Cattle stock in Poland (as of June 2023)

#### Percentage of individual breeds of beef and dairy cattle raised in Poland






#### Poland's self-sufficiency in beef production


## Foreign trade in beef and veal products (in carcass equivalent)




#### The value of exports of meat products\* from Poland in 2022





# Geographical structure of beef\* exports from Poland in 2022 (in product weight)




#### Foreign trade turnover of Polish agri-food products - trade with Japan



**Imports by country of shipment** - the country from which the goods were shipped to Poland, regardless of their origin. The balance was calculated based on the data accurate to a few decimal places.




# Commodity structure of agri-food exports from Poland to Japan in 2022



#### Foreign trade turnover of Polish agri-food products - trade with Hong Kong




# Commodity structure of agri-food exports from Poland to Hong Kong in 2022
